



Was Native Of Baltimore;

Services for Dr. Edith Muriel Harn, retired professor of German and Spanish at Agnes Scott College in Decatur, Ga., and former Baltimore teacher, will be held at 1.30 P.M. Saturday at the Jenkins funeral establishment, 4905 York road.

Dr. Harn, who retired last June after teaching more than 40 years at the Georgia college, died there Tuesday at the age of 70.

She was born in Baltimore, graduating from Western High school in 1911 with a scholarship to Goucher College. At Goucher she completed work on her bachelor's degree, being named to the Phi Beta Kappa scholastic society.

Studied In Berlin

In 1919 she received her Ph.D. degree from the Johns Hopkins University, studying the following year at the University of Berlin.

When she returned from Europe, she taught at St. Timothy's School in Catonsville and at the Friends School before joining the faculty at Agnes Scott College.

Surviving are a sister, Mrs. Pauline H. Oliver, and a brother of John E. Harn.
