

Hearing Tuesday In Isabella Death

Next Tuesday at 11 a.m., has been selected as the date for a preliminary hearing on a mur-der charge against Theodore Vance, 40, of House 251, Isabella,

A general charge of murder A general charge or murner has been filed against Vance in canneellon with the death of James Harrison Dugan, House 212, Isahella, who died early Tuesday morning in a barroom

The hearing will be held in the office of Justice of the Peace Oliver Battaglini of LaBelle. Vance was arraigned before Battaglini yesterday.

State Police said Vance and Dugan got into an altercation at Shubert's Tavern in Isabella and Vance struck the victim in the face with his fist.

Dugan was taken to Browns-ville General Hospital, where he was pronounced dead on arrival at 2:30 a.m.

Faysette County Deputy Coroner Carlo Marucci of Republic said additional laboratory tests are needed to determine the cause of death. A report will be made to County Coroner W. Raiston McGee.
